

Statement of Faith

As a Christian welfare and development body, the Mission affirms its belief in the following biblical doctrine as its doctrinal basis of faith and work.

- A. The Bible: We believe the Bible is the inspired word of God, entirely trustworthy and the supreme authority in all matters of faith and practice.
- B. The Trinity: We believe in one God who exists as three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, eternal and unchanging, cooperating in both the creation of all that exists, and in the salvation of the human race and the whole created order affected by the fall.
- C. Salvation: we believe salvation is offered freely to all lost and sinful humans solely through the sacrificial shedding of Christ's blood on the cross. And is appropriated (by grace not works) by the individual only through faith in that sacrifice, and by the work of regeneration affected by the Holy Spirit.
- D. The Lord Jesus Christ: We believe in the full deity and true humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ. His personal pre-existence, His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles, His vicarious and atoning death, His bodily resurrection, His ascension, His mediatorial work, and His future personal return in power and glory.
- E. The Holy Spirit: We believe in the deity and personality of God the Holy Spirit by whose work the sinner is converted and by whose indwelling the believer is enabled to live a holy life, to witness and to work for the Lord Jesus Christ.
- F. The Church: We believe in the spiritual unity of all who, having believed in the Lord Jesus for their salvation, have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit, and comprise therefore the one holy, universal Church, the body of Christ of which He is the head.
- G. The Great Commission: We believe the primary business of the church and every Christian is to take the full gospel of Jesus Christ to every person.
- H. The Interdenominational Fellowship: We believe that every Christ-witnessing fellowship is part of the universal church of Jesus Christ.
- I. Work: We believe in the doctrine of hard work to earn one's own living yet without compromising one's own holy life (i.e. truthful, transparent, accountable and righteous living).
- J. Politics: We believe in being non-party political and desire to uphold the biblical command to work righteously under any government in authority without being partisan to any political party or movement.

We wish to safeguard individual Christian freedom to differ in areas of doctrine other than the above Statement of Faith.
